The Proclamation of the Word

Does not wisdom call, and does not understanding raise her voice? Thanksgiving over the Water

Celebrant: The Lord be with you.

Anoint her with your Holy Spirit and bring her to new birth in the family of your Church, that she may become an inheritor of your glorious kingdom. Celebrant: Do you turn to Jesus Christ and accept him as your Saviour?
Candidate/Sponsor: I do.
Celebrant: Do you put your whole trust in his grace and love?
Candidate/Sponsor: I do.
Celebrant: Do you promise to obey him as your Lord?
Candidate/Sponsor: I do.

Baptismal Covenant

Celebrant: Let us join with Erinayo who is committing herself to Christ and renew our own baptismal covenant.

Celebrant: Do you believe in God, the Father Almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

People: Yes, I put my hope and trust in God.

Celebrant: Do you believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord. Who was conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and born of the Virgin Mary. Who suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died, and was buried. Who descended to the dead. Who, on the third day, rose again. Who ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of the Father. Who will come again to judge the living and the dead.

People: Yes, I put my hope and trust in God.

Celebrant: Do you believe in God the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting.
